- 1 Login to vCentre UI
- 2 Select Host & Clusters View
- 3 Select your Datacenter

We then need to export the 3x CSV files...

 - a. Select VMs Tab
 - b. Select the pick columns button (bottom left next to export)
 - c. Select the following Column Fields in the tick boxes: Name, Memory Size, Reservation, Status, Used Space, Provisional Space
- 5
 - a. Select Host & Clusters Tab
 - b. Select the pick columns button (bottom left next to export)
 - c. Add CPUs to the list of selected Column Fields in the tick boxes
- 6
 - a. Switch View to Administration
 - b. Click on Licenses
 - c. Click on Assets & Hosts

7 On each of the above hit Export, these metrics can then be exported as CSV files
